AMEC SPIE System Integration secures the Lufthansa Aviation Centre

➤ Fraport AG, which operates the Frankfurt airport, plans to build a new terminal on the site of a former American air base. This will increase the airport's annual passenger capacity from 56 million to 82 million. In parallel to this project, there are plans to significantly extend the entire site to accommodate larger aircraft such as the Airbus A380. In anticipation of its future needs, Deutsche Lufthansa has invested €200 million in the construction of the Lufthansa Aviation Centre, an administration building providing 145,000 m² of facilities for 1,800 employees. AMEC SPIE System Integration handled all technical aspects relating to security for this project. The €1.1 million contract covered the intruder alarm, video surveillance and access systems, media control technology and the complete building control system. ■
