



A team from SPIE Ouest-Centre laid a gas pipeline for Gaz de France in the commune of Saint-Guignoux, Brittany. A total length of nearly 2.8 km of polyethylene piping was laid along a departmental road and in the village centre. The supply network consisted of some 2,490 metres of 125 mm diameter piping and the distribution network was made up of 200 metres of 63 mm diameter piping. The work took four months and was completed in March.
