SPIE wins contract for safety work on Strasbourg light transit system tunnel

Strasbourg transport company - Compagnie des Transports Strasbourgeois □ has chosen the Alsace office's Bas Rhin transport department to carry out safety improvement work on a 1,400-metre long tunnel for its light transit system.

The work to be performed on this tunnel, which contains an underground station in the city's central station area, includes:

- installing six jet fans with related safety equipment,
- boosting the power of two HV/LV transformers,
- modifying the LV power distribution network,
- replacing and upgrading lighting and emergency lighting equipment,
- extending the fire detection system in the tunnel,
- integrating the new safety equipment into the central technical management system.

Following engineering studies due to begin in January 2013, the work is to be carried out this summer for completion in September.
